How can sustainability and security support each other?

The long-term stability and safety of societies depend on responsible management of environmental, social, and economic systems. Integrating sustainability thinking into security strategies helps creating robust, adaptable systems that support both current well-being and the prospects of future generations. The results of unsustainable policies (such as resource scarcity, environmental degradation, and climate change) can increase risks of conflict, social unrest, and instability, threatening both local and global security. Sustainable development addresses the root causes of insecurity, such as poverty, inequality, and ecosystem decline.
