NON-TECHNICAL SUMMARY OF THE IMPACTS ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, ENVIRONMENT AND NATURA 2000

6.I CONCLUSIONS OF THE EVALUATION OF THE IMPACTS ON THE ENVIRONMENT

Within the evaluation itself of the impacts on the environment (part A) and on the basis of a complex evaluation it has been concluded that:

The draft of the update No 1 of the CR SDP as a whole, fulfils a range of requests regarding environmental protection and is in line with the main goals of strategic documents for this area. Its implementation, or more precisely, the implementation of its alterations, new and amended intentions will lead to an improvement of the current state of the environment.

In some newly proposed areas and corridors, potential negative impacts on individual elements of the environment were identified, which are described in a greater detail within the table of evaluation of the individual intentions. To these identified, potentially negative impacts responds a proposal of measures for mitigation or minimization of these impacts.

On the basis of the overall evaluation and all the above stated facts, it is possible to conclude that:

the submitted draft of the update No 1 of the Spatial Development Policy of the CR, will not have a significantly negative effect on the environment, if the stated measures will be complied with.

6.II CONCLUSIONS OF THE EVALUATION OF THE IMPACTS ON NATURA 2000

Within the evaluation itself of the impacts on Natura 2000 (part B) and on the basis of the evaluation it has been concluded that:

the submitted draft of the update No 1 of the Spatial Development Policy of the CR, will not have a significant negative effect on the subjects under protection and on the wholeness of important localities/sites in the European context and on bird areas of Natura 2000, if the stated measures will be complied with.

6.III CONCLUSIONS OF THE EVALUATION OF THE IMPACTS ON AREA SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

On the basis of the overall evaluation of all parts of the evaluation of the impacts on area sustainable development, it is possible to conclude that the draft of the update No 1 of the Spatial Development Policy of the CR fulfils the requirements on area sustainable development, or that it creates preconditions for area sustainable development consisting in a balanced relation of conditions for favourable environment, economic development and for the cohesion of the area's communities of people, and which satisfies the needs of the present generation without threatening the conditions of life of future generations.
